I am pleased to announce that the Texas Education Agency released official 2009 school district accountability ratings on July 31, 2009. Waller ISD received an "Academically Acceptable" school district accountability rating with over **71%** of our schools rated either "Exemplary" or "Recognized". Waller ISD received "Exemplary" on 17 out of 25 indicators, "Recognized" on 7 of the 25 indicators, and "Academically Acceptable" on 1 of the 25 indicators. These are the highest scores in Waller ISD's history!

 - Waller Junior High
 - Waller High School
 - *Waller Jr. High School and Waller High School were "on the bubble" of a "Recognized" school accountability rating*
