

# WALLER ISD REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

District wide registration will be held at Waller High School

Wednesday, July 29----- 7:00am-4:00pm

Thursday, July 30----- 12:00pm-8:00pm

Classes begin August 24, 2009

**The following documents along with the completed registration forms are required to enroll your student(s) in Waller ISD**

1. **Parent or legal guardian must register the student.**  
Legal guardian must have guardianship papers.
2. **Two proofs of residency in the school district**  
(One item from Document A and one item from Document B)  
**Document A: Clarifies ownership of property or relationship to owner of property:**
  - ✓ Deed
  - ✓ WISD Property Tax Statement
  - ✓ Current Lease agreement with property owner
  - ✓ Notarized Statement regarding ownership of property along with Property Tax Statement or Property owner's deed**Document B: Provides verification of current residency on property and intent to continue residency on property.**
  - ✓ Current utility statement with Parent/Guardian Name and Physical Address
  - ✓ Current personal business mail (no unsolicited mailings)
3. **Immunizations Records(See Attached DSHS requirements)**  
Students must be fully immunized following the Department of State Health Services requirements.
4. **Social Security Card**
5. **State Certified Birth Certificate**
6. **Last Report Card / Transcripts**  
Documentation showing grade level
7. **Come prepared to draw a map from the school to your home**  
Transportation must have a map before a bus number will be issued.

## SPECIAL INFORMATION FOR KINDERGARTEN & PRE-KINDERGARTEN

**Kindergarten** students must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2009

**Pre -Kindergarten** students must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2009.

Appropriate pre-kindergarten staff determines student eligibility for Pre-K enrollment.

Student must meet one of the following criteria.

1. Student does not speak or comprehend the English language
2. Student is educationally disadvantaged if student is eligible to participate in National Free or Reduced Price lunch program. Recent income documentation must be furnished.
3. Student is determined to be homeless
4. Student is child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the U.S.
5. Student is child of a member of armed forces who was injured or killed while serving on active duty.
6. Student has been in conservatorship (foster care) of the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) following and adversary hearing.
